INTRODUCTION

ARC EN CIRQUE, Centre Régional des Arts du Cirque de Chambéry is a non-profit organisation established in 1987. It comprises three facilities: the Centre for Professional Circus Arts Training, the Centre for Amateur Performance, and the Centre for Resources and Exchange, which includes a resource library and facilities for hosting artists and companies in residence.

Accredited by the French Federation of Circus Schools (FFEC) as a professional training centre and member of the European Federation of Professional Circus Schools (FEDEC), Arc en Cirque offers a **Preparatory Training** programme funded and supported by the Rhône-Alpes regional authorities and the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes regional department for cultural affairs. Arc en Cirque is listed in the Datadock registry, meaning that it meets the criteria of France's "training quality" decree of 30 June 2015 and is therefore eligible to receive funding from professional training funders. The Centre Régional des Arts du Cirque de Chambéry has also obtained France's Qualiopi certification in recognition of its high standard of training.

Many students who have attended the Preparatory Training programme have subsequently been accepted into **higher education establishments**: including CNAC (Châlons-en-Champagne), ESACTO (Toulouse), Académie Fratellini (La Plaine Saint-Denis), ESAC (Bruxelles), ENC (Montreal), Ecole de Cirque de Québec, the NCCA (London), DOCH (Stockholm), ACAPA (Tilburg), and CODARTS (Rotterdam),...

And into **Artistic Training**: including CRAC Arc en Cirque (Chambéry), CRAC Balthazar (Montpellier), CRAC Lomme (Lille), CRAC Piste d'Azur (La Roquette sur Siagne), Samovar (Paris),...

PREPARATORY TRAINING FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

Preparation for entrance examinations to higher education establishments or artistic training: preparatory professional, technical and artistic training offered over two years.

AIM OF THE PREPARATORY TRAINING

To prepare students for entrance examinations at higher education establishments/artistic training at national and international circus arts schools.

PROGRAMME DURATION, TIMETABLE AND COST

- 2,200 hours of preparatory training over two years from September 2024 to end-June/early July 2026
- 1,100 hours/year, of which 960 hours at the Centre and 140 hours/year in internship
- 32 hours/week on average

The programme is funded by the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes regional authorities.

Applicants are responsible for the annual €600 registration fee for Arc en Cirque in addition to their living expenses (accommodation, meals, healthcare, etc).

Successful applicants from France or other European countries will have non-remunerated "vocational trainee" status.

PROGRAMME

The programme is organised into training units with a focus on general and specific physical conditioning, acrobatics, circus techniques and artistic disciplines such as dance and expression.

Year 1: Students build on their technical and artistic skills.

Year 2: Students refine their technical and artistic skills and begin creating a technical and artistic sequence that they will use to audition for their chosen circus schools.

Dear Doctor,

Re: Information regarding the issuance of a medical certificate for those applying for professional training at Arc en Cirque

The Centre Régional des Arts du Cirque "Arc en Cirque" de Chambéry is a professional training centre for Circus Arts.

It is accredited and recognised for its preparatory training programmes by the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes regional authorities, the French Ministry of Culture (through the regional department of cultural affairs or "DRAC"), the French Federation of Circus Schools (FFEC) and the European Federation of Professional Circus Schools (FEDEC).

It offers two training programmes:

- Two-year programme: Preparatory Training to prepare students for entrance examinations
- Three-year programme: Artistic Training

For more than 15 years, we have been setting rigorous health standards for our students, whose average age is 21. We provide them with orthopaedic check-ups, performed by myself, at the beginning of the school year, and set them goals and targets. We also teach classes on traumatology, accident prevention and stretching, and provide students with timely access to a treatment network tailored to the specific demands of Circus Arts.

Circus Arts comprise:

- gymnastics: floor and aerial acrobatics
- ball work: juggling (dexterity, coordination)
- wrestling: including lifting
- climbing: balance and traction work
- sometimes horse riding (not in Chambéry)

The purpose of this letter describing our activity is to stress the importance of this sports physical examination.

Our training programmes are full-time and very intense, and the physical commitment required from students is similar to that of top-level athletes.

We consider this medical fitness certificate to be the fundamental basis on which these young artist-athletes will take responsibility for their bodies, which will be so involved in their future profession.

Our statistical analysis of trauma and injuries to athletes, produced over the past seven years, shows that the areas most prone to injury are the lumbopelvic region (35% of cases), followed by the knees (16% of cases) and the shoulders (13% of cases).

Assurances about the integrity of our students' lumbopelvic region are therefore crucial to us as a training centre and even more so to the students themselves, who are about to choose their long-term specialisations.

The most recent information from the French Ministry for Youth and Sport (decrees of 6 February 2004 and 1 February 2004) regarding targeted preventive screening for top-level athletes is reflected in the clarity of our own approach.

Your examination and subsequent issuance of a Certificate of Fitness is a mandatory part of our selection process.

In addition to the above certificate, students selected by the school must also undergo a lumbopelvic x-ray, at their expense , before their admission can be approved.


